

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES CHECKLIST

Thank you for your interest in Family Christian Academy. We are excited at the prospect of your family joining our school.

To enroll your child, the following forms and procedures are required:

- □ Signed Statement of Faith (one per family)
- □ Student Testimony Form (for students applying to grades 6-12)
- □ A completed *Pastor Recommendation Form* (one per family)
- □ A completed Request for Release of School Records
- □ A completed *Teacher Recommendation Form* (one for each student)
- □ A copy of the student's most recent and previous year's Report Card
- □ A copy of the student's most recent Standardized Test Scores (FSA, SAT, IOWA, Terra Nova, etc)
- □ A current copy of your student's IEP, 504, or medical concerns that are educationally relevant
- □ Florida Certificate of Immunization (DH #680)
- □ Florida Student Health Examination form (DH #3040)
- □ Copy of the student's Birth Certificate
- □ \$75 Non-Refundable Application Fee

Once all paperwork is received, an Administrator will review the records and the Admissions Coordinator will schedule an academic assessment for the student.

After the assessment, one of our Deans and the Admissions Coordinator will conduct a family interview to determine enrollment eligibility.

Upon acceptance, parents will meet with the finance department to complete the following forms:
